## Fashion Illustration

The style of the garment drawn in your illustration is your choice. Theme will be "It's Showtime". It will be judged on originality, use of colour, texture, tone and mood. To be A3 size and mounted onto Black Card.

## Wearable Art – Any material – Design & Technique

The garment can be assembled using any medium and constructed using any method. Be creative. It is to be 'Art that walks while you wear it'.

## Original Textile Design – any textile/daywear

The garment can be constructed out of any textile material and will be judged on the actual sewing of garment. Garment is to be a daywear garment.

## Recycled Materials (fabric, metal, plastic, paper, etc.)

Your entire outer garment must be made from recycled materials which must have had a previous use and not be a used garment. An undergarment may be used for structural support only.

## Masks

Masks to be completely constructed by the entrant including the base. Any medium or combination of mediums can be used.

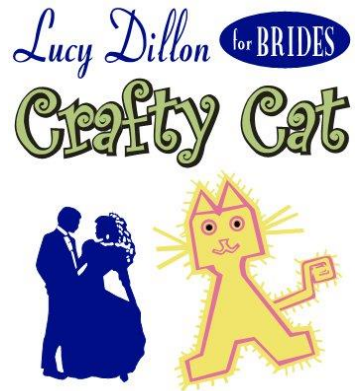

# FASHION ON SHOW

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## Regulations

1. The Judge retains the right to award any or none of the prizes listed if quality or quantity of exhibits is inadequate.
2. If entries are not in the correct category the Judge and the Steward retains the right to move to correct section.
3. All entries must be completely finished and to be of the entrant's own work.
4. A single entry cannot be entered in more than one class. All entries must have own model.
5. The judge's decision shall be final.
6. If you do happen to win a prize a letter of thanks would be appreciated to the sponsor of that section.
7. All entries must be picked up by date indicated on the first page of this form, any entries that are left after one month from this date will be disposed of.
8. All care is taken but no responsibility will be accepted by the Society for damage of any exhibit, including broken glass.
9. Garments in classes 34004 – 34015 are to be modelled. Model to be supplied by entrant.
10. An entry form must be received for each entrant.
11. All illustrations for the ***Fashion Illustration*** competition must be A3 size and mounted onto black card
12. All illustrations must have the entrants Name, Address, Phone Number and age on the back of the black card.
13. Fashion Illustrations: you can use pen, pencil, watercolour also the use of swatches is acceptable if you wish.
