

Mackay Show Showjumping

Conditions of Entry

- > Camping parking and stables are allocated and will be strictly adhered to by Stewards
- ➤ No straw bedding allowed your own bedding must be supplied. No camping will be allowed in the ring. NO electric fences allowed
- ➤ PLEASE NOTE STABLING IS AT A MINIMUM If you want to guarantee yourself a stable, stables must be booked and pre-paid
- ➤ If Stables are not left clean a fee of \$50/stable will be charged for cleaning. If this invoice is left unpaid no further nominations or stable bookings will be taken from persons responsible.
- > A cancellation fee of \$25.00 will apply per booking
- 1. All horses must be measured before entering the ring.
- 2. All protests must be lodged within 15mins and a \$50 fee will apply. No other complaints of protest will be heard unless the correct procedure has been adhered to.
- 3. No refunds under any circumstances
- **4.** All handlers in the marshaling area must be there ready to enter the ring or holding horses.
- **5.** No horses to be tied up or left unattended.
- **6.** Please keep all areas clean and free of rubbish. Plenty of bins are provided around for the disposal of any refuse.
- **7.** All horses entered in junior performance classes must be 12 months actual age or older and all horses entered in senior performance events must be 36 months actual age or older.
- 8. Foals under 4months must be accompanied to the ring by their dams and must be halter trained.
- 9. All foals under 6months of age must be 28" or under to compete in Miniature Horse classes.
- **10. DISTRICT**: The district shall be anywhere from Mackay, South to Rockhampton, West to Emerald and North to Townsville. Horses/Ponies must be domiciled in the district for a total period of 3 months immediately preceding the date of Mackay Show and must be owned and ridden by persons living in this district for a total period of 3 months immediately preceding the date of Mackay Show
- 11. Approved safety helmets as per EA rules. (3838 or better) MUST be worn by children under 17 years competing in all classes and showjumping events. All competitors must comply with this rule. The Association will not be responsible for any accident or injury that results from failure to wear approved safety helmets
- **12.** All competitors/exhibitors are required to sign the official indemnity form as a condition of acceptance of entries
- **13.** Please note: EA Members, sponsors, special guests of the Association and management committee appointed stewards, only admitted to the ring during equestrian/showjumping competition
- **14.** The Committee reserves the right to alter, amend or cancel any event in this schedule at any time, and without notice

Mackay Show Showjumping

Showjumping Rules and Regulations

- 1. All events will be conducted under EA Rules
- 2. The organising committee reserves the right to change this program at any time
- 3. Where there are less than 10 entries in any class, the organising committee reserves the right to combine or cancel the class
- **4.** The organising committee reserves the right to change the prizes / prizemoney
- 5. Competitors compete at their risk (all riders <u>must</u> wear helmets that are Safety Standard Approved)
- **6.** Prizemoney is forfeited, if the respective performance card is not produced
- For duration of the show each horse is <u>allowed two starts per day</u> combined events are classed as one start
- 8. A horse can only compete in one Championship class
- 9. Children my compete in Children's classes until the end of the calendar year they turn 14 years old
- **10.** Juniors 16yrs -18yrs may compete in both Junior and Young Rider, keeping in mind the two starts a day rule and only one Championship per horse
- **11. Junior rider:** from the beginning of the Calendar year in which they reach the age of 12, until the end of the Calendar year in which they reach the age of 18
- **12. Young rider:** from the beginning of the Calendar year in which they reach the age of 16, until the end of the Calendar year in which they reach the age of 21
- 13. Amateur Rider; athlete must not have competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing. In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders or 4* eventing. Must not have competed in section 1 or 2 at a Royal Show in Brisbane, Sydney, Melbourne, Adelaide, or Perth in the last two years. May not compete in an Amateurs class, if they compete in a class where first round is higher than 1.20 at that show.
 - Athletes Must meet the requirements as set out in the EA General Regulations.
 - Athletes may compete as Amateurs from the beginning of the year they turn 21
